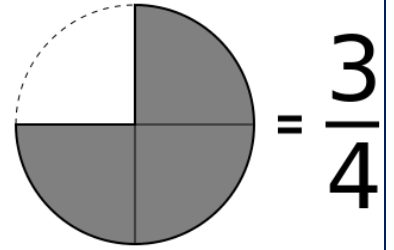

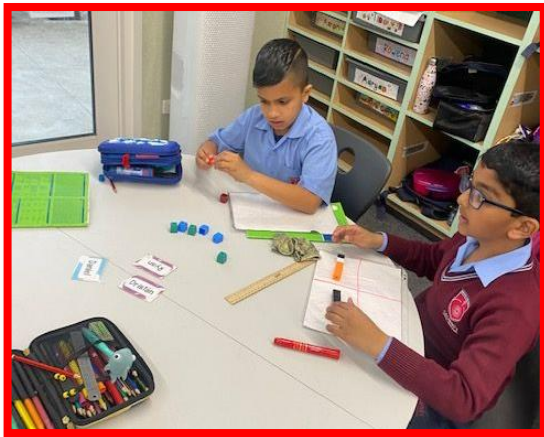
3RD
