Eleven of our Glowrey students will be receiving the sacrament of Eucharist for the first time. They have been working hard with their teachers to be fully prepared in every way.


The sacrament takes place on Saturday, May 6th at St Peter's Church. We wish these students all the blessings in the world for their special day.






# YEAR 5 - MENTAL COMPUTATION

















# **Glowrey Book Club**


# Parent Resource for Year 5 and 6 students
